## Rules, Division, and Classes

### 1. EXHIBITORS REQUIREMENTS:

Exhibitor must be either a resident of Milam County or attend school in Milam County plus meet the following requirements:

- A. Must be enrolled in a public or private elementary or secondary school.
- B. Must be a minimum of five years old and in kindergarten as of August 31, 2011.
- C. Open to all youth in Milam County.

### 2. ENTRY FEE:

There will be a fee of \$5.00 per entry. Entry forms may be obtained from your school, 4-H club manager, Milam County Extension Office, or website <http://milam-tx.tamu.edu/>. Entry forms and fees need to be submitted to the Milam County Extension Office by February 21, 2012 or to the MCJLS Board during Entry Sign-Up Nights. Late entries will be accepted at the Milam County Extension Office until 5:00 p.m. on March 15, 2012. The fee for a late entry will be a total of \$8.00 per item.

### 3. AGE DIVISIONS:

- A. Beginner Division – Open to anyone between the ages of 5 - 8  
(as long as they are in one of the following grades –  
Kindergarten, 1<sup>st</sup> or 2<sup>nd</sup> grades)
- B. Junior Division – Open to anyone between the ages of 8 and in the 3<sup>rd</sup> Grade - 10 years  
of age (as of August 31, 2011)
- C. Intermediate Division – Open to anyone between the ages of 11- 13 (as of August 31, 2011)
- D. Senior Division - Open to anyone between the ages of 14- 19 (as of August 31, 2011)

### 4. GUIDELINES:

- A. Articles that have won grand champion at another show/fair are not eligible to enter this show.
- B. All articles must have been completed since March 2011.
- C. All exhibits must be made by the exhibitors.
- D. One entry per class per person. (For example — a class of breads. A youth may enter only one bread, but may also enter one pie and one cake if they wish. That would be a total of \$15.00 entry fee.)
- E. All entries must be checked in and checked out.
- F. Every precaution will be taken to protect all articles entered, but in no case will the livestock association, the home economics division, or the Texas AgriLife Extension Service - Milam County be responsible for loss, damage, theft, or breakage or any other form of loss.
- G. There will not be any sale of items entered.

5. **AWARDS:**

- A. All exhibits will be scored and will receive a ribbon (1<sup>st</sup> through 10<sup>th</sup> placing or participation ribbon with 1<sup>st</sup> place being Grand Champion and 2<sup>nd</sup> place being Reserve Champion).
- B. Judges will not award a prize to any unworthy exhibit and the decision of the judges will be final.

6. **HOME ECONOMICS DIVISIONS AND CLASSES:**

A. ARTISTIC ARRANGEMENT DIVISION:

- A-1. All fresh green & flower plant material
- A-2. Dried material, natural state or treated
- A-3. Wreaths and Wall Hangings
- A-4. Miscellaneous

B. CLOTHING DIVISION:

- B-1. Embellished Items (including garments, accessories, pillows, wall hangings, etc.)
- B-2. Accessories (constructed items)
- B-3. Garments (constructed items)
- B-4. Stuffed Animals (constructed items)
- B-5. Miscellaneous (constructed items such as aprons, pillows, etc.)

C. CREATIVE ART DIVISION:

- C-1. Ceramics
- C-2. Jewelry
- C-3. Models
- C-4. Holiday crafts/decorations
- C-5. Painted and/or stenciled
- C-6. Fiber Arts (leather, string, yarn, etc.)
- C-7. Miscellaneous

D. COLLECTION / DISPLAY DIVISION:

- Collections – such as dolls, rocks, stamps, coins, insects, wildflowers, sports cards, etc.
- Displays – showing a step by step process, procedure, or exhibit explaining or teaching a point.
- D-1. Collections
- D-2. Displays

E. DRAWING DIVISION:

- Entries can be mounted, matted or framed, but it is not required.
- Entries can be pen, ink, pencil, charcoal, crayon or other media.

- E-3. Flora/Plant
- E-4. Still Life
- E-5. Landscape
- E-6. Miscellaneous

F. FOOD DIVISION:

- A recipe must be submitted with all Food Division entries.
- F-1. Breads - quick and yeast, 1 loaf or 3 of a kind on rolls or muffins
- F-2. Cakes
- F-3. Cookies - 6 of a kind
- F-4. Pies - both fruit and custard
- F-5. Celebration of Chocolate (a food item containing chocolate)

G. PAINTING DIVISION:

- Entries can be mounted, matted or framed, but it is not required.
- Entries can be oil, water colors, acrylics, and other media
- G-1. People
- G-2. Animals
- G-3. Flora/Plant
- G-4. Still Life
- G-5. Landscape
- G-6. Miscellaneous

H. PHOTOGRAPHY DIVISION:

- Pictures may be enlarged or cropped.
- Entries may be mounted, matted or framed, but it is not required.
- Pictures can be digital or film photos
- H-1. Photo Story - communicates a message, shows a sequence of events, or series.
- H-2. People - Black & White
- H-3. Animals - Black & White
- H-4. Still Life - Black & White
- H-5. Flora/Plant - Black & White
- H-6. Landscape - Black & White
- H-7. People - Color and Color
- H-8. Animals - Color and Color
- H-9. Still Life - Color and Color
- H-10. Flora/Plant - Color and Color
- H-11. Landscape - Color and Color
- H-12. Architectural Elements - Black & White Photos

I. SCRAPBOOKING DIVISION:

- Entries can include one or more pages. Multiple pages need to be placed in a book.
